We will be walking on the ferry, but all routes are wheelchair accessible and it's only 2 very short blocks to the boat launch. We'll save a lot of money doing it this way! Price includes our bus transportation to and from Bainbridge ferry, Argosy Ticket and return ferry fare. **Bus leaves at 8:30 a.m. from SSAC** to catch 10:25 ferry. Please pack a lunch or plan to grab something during the hour we'll spend enjoying the waterfront before our 12:15 sailing.
