Protection Island National Wildlife Refuge



Our most popular cruise for wildlife viewing. Seabirds, bald eagles, harbor seals, harbor porpoises, elephant seals and more can be seen. Approximately 70 percent of the nesting seabirds from this area breed and nest on the island. It also claims one of the largest nesting colonies of rhinoceros auklets in the world and the largest nesting colony of glaucous-winged gulls in Washington. The island contains one of the last 2 nesting colonies of tufted puffins in the Puget Sound area. About 1,000 harbor seals depend upon the island for a pupping and rest area. This is about a 2 hour cruise.



Light House Cruises

There are several lighthouses in our area including New Dungeness, Pt. Wilson, Ft. Casey, Marrowstone Island and more. We cruise by these stations and give you an historical tour of each. This is a 3-4 hour cruise.

Friday Harbor - San Juan Islands

The Pacific Northwest has an inviting secret spot known as the San Juan Islands. The 247 days of sunshine and half the rain of Seattle, Washington make the San Juan Islands the perfect year-round getaway! San Juan County, with more than 375 miles of rocky and sandy waterfront, boasts more shoreline than any other county in the nation. These islands have been luring explorers and visitors with a natural beauty full of surprises since they were first discovered. Many sea birds, seals, porpoises, Stellar Sea Lions and Orcas are in this area along the way. This cruise is a full day trip with a lunch stop at Friday Harbor on San Juan Island.



Deception Pass – LaConner



Cruise from Sequim through north Whidbey's Deception Pass, then on through Skagit Bay into the Stillaguamish Channel to LaConner. Enjoy lunch and shopping at any number of downtown venues upon arrival. Transportation to town is included along with a **coupon book** for stores and restaurants! This is an all day trip.
